

Village of Marwayne
BY-LAW NO. 422 -99

- A Bylaw** of the Village of Marwayne in the Province of Alberta concerning the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy.
- And Whereas** pursuant to Section 89 of the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*, S.A. 1994, c. F-18.5, the Village of Marwayne must designate a person or group of persons as the head of the Village of Marwayne for the purpose of the Act;
- Purpose:** The purpose of this Bylaw is to establish the administrative structure of the Village of Marwayne in relation to the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*, and to set fees thereunder.
- Definitions:** In this Bylaw, unless the context otherwise requires:
1. the “Act” means the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*, S.A.1994,c.F-18.5;
 2. “Applicant” means a person who makes a request for access to a record under section 7 (1) of the Act;
 3. “Chief Administrative Officer” means the person appointed as the Chief Administrative Officer of the Village of Marwayne, and includes any person who holds the position of CAO in an Acting capacity;
 4. “Province” means the Province of Alberta
- Designated Head** for the purpose of the Act, the Chief Administrative Official is designated as the Head of the Village of Marwayne.
- Fees** Where an Applicant is required to pay a fee for services, the fee payable is in accordance with the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Regulation*, AR 200/95, as amended from time to time or any successor Regulation that sets fees for requests for information from the Province.
- Effective date** This Bylaw comes into effect on October 1, 1999.
- Read** for the first time this 13th day of September, 1999.
- Read** for the second time this 13th day of September, 1999.
- Read** for the third and duly passed in open Council this 13th day of September, A.D.1999.
