
#### 4th Annual Legion Slo-Pitch Tournament

#### WHO IS THE "WALKING THROUGH GRIEF SOCIETY" ?

Walking Through Grief Society is a nondenominational, Non Profit, Volunteer Based Society.

#### What is the mandate of the Society?

The Society believes that Grief is normal.

- Grief affects people of all ages and from all walks of life.
- Each person is unique and should be allowed to grieve in their own unique way.
- Everyone needs a safe, supportive, respectful and loving environment to deal with life losses
- Walking Through Grief Society exists to ensure that no one needs to walk alone, unsupported through their grief journey.
- Walking Through Grief Society offers individual or group support for those experiencing life losses and are grieving and finding coping difficult. Support reduces isolation, offers skills to navigate their grief journey, which in turn, empowers each and will help to develop resilience in future life crisis.

Where is the Society located? The Society reaches out to offer programming in Lloydminster, Vermilion and Wainwright, also including their marketing areas.

What is the cost to attend programs? There is no fee for programs but donations are gratefully accepted and tax deductible receipts are offered. FCSS offers basic funding to operate and is offered by the municipalities of City of Lloydminster, Towns of Vermilion and Wainwright and the Villages of Kitscoty and Marwayne ,and the County of Vermilion River.

What programs are offered? Programs offered are support groups for Adults, children, individual support, support for those developmentally delayed, those who are Palliative and their families, survivors of suicide and those impacted by violent deaths.

The Society is pleased to offer Awareness Presentations to the public. The Society is part of the planning committee for the Suicide Walk of Remembrance and recognizes the "Infant Loss Awareness Day" in October, "Trauma and Family Violence "and "The Year of Firsts" with an event. Conferences are planned for the public and partnered with other agencies or organizations.


**Who runs the Society and programs?** There is a Board of 11 members, facilitators for each area and for children's program. The Society is always ready to welcome those who wish to volunteer on the Board or in the programming. Fall programming will begin in early September in all areas.






