PLASTICS 1-7

- · Milk Jugs, Drink Bottles
- Bleach, Soap, Fabric Softener Bottles
- · Pill Bottles, Plastic Tubs


ALL CONTAINERS MUST BE EMPTY, RINSED AND LIDS REMOVED.

Plastic Recyclables must have one of the Following symbols, and must not be black.

METAL

- · Pop, Beer, Drink Cans
- Aluminum Foil
- Aluminum Containers
- Tin Cans & Lids

ALL CONTAINERS MUST BE EMPTY, RINSED AND LIDS REMOVED



CARDBOARD AND PAPER

- Paper, Newspaper, Flyers, Magazines, Books
- Milk Cartons, Tetra-Paks, Cardboard Egg Cartons
- Shredded Paper (In a bag, separate from other items).

CARDBOARD MUST BE BROKEN DOWN OR FLATTENED BEFORE BEING PLACED IN THE BIN.

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS FOR RECYCLING:

Aerosol Cans, All Glass, Air Fresheners, Ant-Static Sheets, Glass Baby Food Jars, Bakeware, Band-aids, Batteries, Black Plastic, Bricks, Bubble Wrap, Cellophane, Ceramics, Cereal Box Liners, Clay Containers or Bakeware, Cigarettes, Clean or Soiled Wipes, Cloth & Clothes, Corks, Diapers, Dry Cleaner Bags, Wet Waste, Knives, Laminated Paper, Leather, Light Bulbs, Mirrors, Nails, Needles, Nuts and Bolts, Paint Cans, Plastic Grocery Bags, Plastic Caps, Ribbon, Rope, Rubber Bands, Scissors, Styrofoam, Toothbrushes, Twine, Zip-Lock Bags

NEEDLES MUST BE PLACED IN A HARD CONTAINER AND TAKEN TO AN ALBERTA HEALTH FACILITY

PAINT CANS, AEROSOL CANS, BATTERIES CAN BE PLACED IN THE PROPER BIN AT THE TRANSFER STATION. ALL OTHER UNACCEPTABLE WASTE CAN BE DISPOSED OF IN THE HOUSEHOLD WASTE BINS AT THE TRANSFER SITE
